

Theydon Bois Primary School Uniform Policy

Uniform

All children are expected to wear school uniform (all clearly labelled with child's name) as follows:

Boys	
Green School Blazer with logo* (optional for all – preferred in Year 5 and 6)	Blazer must be worn with white shirt and school tie. Top buttons must be present and must be fastened.
Grey trousers/shorts	
Bottle Green long-sleeved V-neck sweatshirt with logo*	Can be worn under blazer. Normally worn with shirt (and tie.) Can be worn without blazer or tie. Not for PE.
White shirt	
School tie	Optional but must be worn if wearing blazer
Black or grey socks	
Plain black shoes	Not suede, canvas or trainer style . Trainers can be kept in school for Mile a Day.

Girls	
Green School Blazer with logo* (optional for all – preferred in Year 5 and 6)	Blazer must be worn with white shirt and school tie. Top buttons must be present and must be fastened. Can also be worn with summer dress – no tie.
Grey skirt - ideally no shorter than knee length/pinafore/school trousers (NO leggings)	
Bottle Green long-sleeved V-neck sweatshirt with logo or bottle green long sleeved cardigan with logo*	Can be worn under blazer. Normally worn with shirt (and tie). Can be worn without blazer or tie. Not for PE
White shirt/blouse	
School tie	Optional but must be worn if wearing blazer
Green checked summer dress	April to October only

White or grey plain socks or grey or bottle green tights

PE (Boys and Girls)	
School PE top*	
Black shorts* (no skorts) Optional for girls: plain black sports leggings	Must be plain black – not see through – no large logos/ patterns or stripes.
School tracksuit*	Plain black track suit bottoms
Black skins can be worn under PE top	October to April only
White socks	
Black plimsolls – EYFS	Indoor PE
Predominantly Black trainers (all years)	All outdoor sessions – trainers – KS 1 to KS2

School book bag * School PE bag* School rucksacks*

EYFS

PE kit including a school tracksuit and pair of socks, should be stored in a simple, named, drawstring bag which should remain at school at all times. A PE bag with the school logo is available from Forest Casual.

Key Stage 1 and 2

Come to school dressed in PE kit on the days they have PE lessons or sporting activities.

Jewellery and Hair

Jewellery is not allowed, as it can be dangerous in school. Stud earrings are tolerated, but must be removed for PE and swimming. Children should be able to do this by themselves. The Local Authority health and safety policy states ‘that all jewellery and other personal adornments constitute a hazard and must be removed before the PE lesson’. Watches may be worn, but should be named in some way, (initials in Tippex) and removed for PE. Smart watches are not allowed.

Nail varnish is not permitted under any circumstances. Long hair should be tied back at all times. Any hair clips, bows or bands should be of a sensible size and in the school colours, ie, green, grey or white. We will request that inappropriate items are removed.
